Setting Up Your E-mail in iPhone

This tutorial shows you how to set up iPhone to work with your e-mail account. This tutorial focuses on setting up iPhone, but these settings are similar in other versions of iOS. You can set up previous versions of iOS by using the settings in this tutorial.

To Set Up Your E-mail Account in iPhone

1. If this is the first account you're setting up on the iPhone or the iPod Touch, tap Mail. Otherwise, from the Home screen choose **Settings > Mail, Contacts, Calendars**





2. Choose "Add Account...". For setting up email to work with your (mt) Media Temple service choose Other.

Incoming mail server (IMAP / POP)

Enter qm1.webnix.com or use your provided domain name IMAP/Pop3 server address for your incoming mail server. (E.g. your domain is abc.com -> Your IMAP/POP3 Server: mail.abc.com)

Outgoing mail server (SMTP)

Enter your SMTP server for your outgoing mail server. (E.g. your domain is abc.com -> Your IMAP/Pop3 Server: mail.abc.com)



5. Enter in mail.yourdomain.com for the Outgoing Mail Server host name. Enter your full email address and password below the host name. Your iPhone will then verify your account information.

8. Ensure "Use SSL" is off. If you select "POP" type in step (4), please select "**Never**" at "**Delete from server**" (Recommended Setting)

10. Select "SMTP" in "Outgoing Mail Server", and select "Primary Server"



11. Please also ensure "Use SSL" is off. And change the SMTP Port from ${\bf 25}$ to ${\bf 6025}$
